All transfer applications to the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth Year or Sixth Year Group in St Patrick's College, Lacken Cross will only be accepted after the 24th April 2023 and the closing date for receipt of applications is the 31st May 2023.

Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All applicants to the First-Year Group will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	13 th March 2023
Successful applicants to the First Year Group must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	3 rd April 2023

Note: Failure to accept an offer of admission before the relevant deadline set out above may result in the offer being withdrawn.
